The first-ever National Voter's Day was celebrated on January 25, 2011 to mark the Foundation Day of the Election Commission of India, i.e. 25th January 1950. At that time, it was noted that new voters who attained the age of 18 were showing less interest in getting enrolled in the electoral process. To address this issue, in 2011 the Election Commission decided to launch a nationwide effort to identify all eligible voters who reach the age of 18 on January 1st of each year in all polling stations across India and issue them the Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC) on January 25th of every year to encourage more young voters to take part in the electoral process. This year, it is the 12th edition being celebrated.

As per the guidelines received from M.U.H.S. through letter no. MUHS/SW/NSS/81/2022 dated 18/01/2022, Rashtriya Matadaar Din (National Voter's Day) was celebrated in B.S.D.T's Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Wagholi, Pune on 25/01/2022. The theme for this year is 'Making Elections Inclusive, Accessible and Participative' to facilitate active participation of voters during the elections and to make the process hassle free and memorable for all categories of voters.


