Sir/Madam,

- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely to Bharatiya Sanskriti Darshan Trust's Ayurved Mahavidyalaya , Vishwashanti Dham, off Kesnanad Road, A/P Wagholi, Tal.-Haveli, Dist.-Pune-412207, Maharashtra (AYU0152) inspection was conducted on 24.03.2025 and 25.03.2025 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with an intake capacity of 60 seats and 15 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely in the subject namely - (i) Ayurveda Samhita, Sanskrit and Siddhant - 03 seats (ii) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (iii) Rog Nidan-Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan -03 seats (iv) Kayachikitsa - 03 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 1st renewal of permission in 01 PG Course with 03 seats in the department of Panchkarma under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-

1. Teaching staffs:-

a) Availability of total teaching staff for UG(BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is



- The assessment report was duly placed in the 134th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 16.07.2025 and Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of extended permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Extended permission in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission with an intake capacity of 60 seats and 15 Seats in 04 PG Courses in the subject namely - (i) Ayurveda Samhita, Sanskrit and Siddhant - 03 seats (ii) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (iii) Rog Nidan-Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan -03 seats (iv) Kayachikitsa - 03 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 1st renewal of permission in 01 PG Course with 03 seats in the department of Panchkarma under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

- Therefore, Extended permission is hereby granted to Bharatiya Sanskriti Darshan Trust's Ayurved Mahavidyalaya , Vishwashanti Dham, off Kesnanad Road, A/P Wagholi, Tal.-Haveli, Dist.-Pune-412207, Maharashtra (AYU0152) with an intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and board policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 and 15



Seats in 04 PG in accordance with Regulation 15 (5) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 in the subject namely - (i) Ayurveda Samhita, Sanskrit and Siddhant - 03 seats (ii) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (iii) Rog Nidan-Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan -03 seats (iv) Kayachikitsa - 03 seats section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, and 1st renewal of permission in 01 PG Course with 03 seats in the department of Panchkarma under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26 subject to condition that the aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-

- I. Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats and 15% of Postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 18 seats in 05 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
6. Further, as per **Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
8. **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
9. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024,
 - iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - v) The shortcoming mentioned in para no. 2.
 - vi) The remaining visitation fee as communicated in the letter dated 28.01.2025.
10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-2027.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am to refer to your application vide **Ref. No. vide ref. no. BSDTAM/23 dated 30.08.2023**, on the subject cited above and to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college namely **Bhartiya Sanskriti Darshan Trust Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Vishwashanti Dham, Off Kesnand Road, A/P Wagholi, Tal- Haveli, Dist-Pune 412207, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0152)**, your college was visited on **27.12.2023 & 28.12.2023** for the issuance of LOI to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely **Panchkarma-03 seats** from the academic session 2024-25 and the Letter of Intent (LoI) has been issued to your college vide letter of **even no. dated 05.02.2024** to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely **Panchkarma-03 seats**, under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2024-25.
2. Thereafter, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the college again on **14.03.2024 & 15.03.2024** through **Hybrid mode** to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities available as a part of annual visitation for **issuance of conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 Seats in 04 PG Courses** namely -(i) **Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant-03 seats** (ii) **Rachna Sharir-06 seats** (iii) **Kayachikitsa-03 seats** (iv) **Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 03 Seats**, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 and for issuance of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely **Panchkarma-03 seats**, under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2024-25.



3. Further, in view of above assessment report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
4. Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **96th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **05.07.2024**. **The Board Concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, accordingly the college is fulfilling the criteria required for issuance of conditional permission as per the Regulation 3 (3) of MSR 2016. Hence, the Board decided to grant of conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely –(i) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant-03 seats (ii) Rachna Sharir-06 seats (iii) Kayachikitsa-03 seats (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan – 03 Seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and issuance of Letter of Permission to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Panchkarma-03 seats, under section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 from academic session 2024-25.**
5. Further, in accordance of the regulation **6 (2) (i) (i)** of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019 letter of even no. **dated 17.07.2024** was sent to you to furnish fixed security deposit worth **Rupees 50 lakhs** for a period of three years in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine. In response of the same your college has furnished the fixed security deposit in favor of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine of **Rupees 50 lakhs** through online payment mode **RTGS Ref no. SRCBH24243951444 dated 30.08.2024 Saraswat Bank Dhanukar Branch and informed the same vide letter ref. No. BSDAM/24/EXT-251 dated 31.08.2024 by an email dated 31.08.2024.**
6. Therefore, Conditional Permission is issued to **Bhartiya Sanskriti Darshan Trust Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Vishwashanti Dham, Off Kesnand Road, A/P Wagholi, Tal- Haveli, Dist-Pune 412207, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0152)** with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 Seats in 04 PG Courses namely –(i) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant-03 seats (ii) Rachna Sharir-06 seats (iii) Kayachikitsa-03 seats (iv) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan – 03 Seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 and Letter of Permission (LOP) is issued to start 01 new PG course in the subject namely Panchkarma-03 seats from the academic session 2024-25, under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions:**

 - i. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - ii. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 18 seats in 05 PG Courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - iii. 



Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, quirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. AYU0152)** inspection of your College was conducted on **25.05.2023 & 26.05.2023** on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 Seats in 04 Course** namely - (1) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 03 seats (2) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (3) Kayachikitsa - 03 seats (4) Rog Nidan - Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 03 Seats for the academic session **2023-24** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **47th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **13.07.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, hence Board decided to issue the Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 Seats in 04 Course** namely - (1) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 03 seats (2) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (3) Kayachikitsa - 03 seats (4) Rog Nidan - Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 03 Seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session **2023-24**.
4. Therefore, **conditional permission is granted to Bhartiya Sanskriti Darshan Trust Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Vishwashanti Dham, Off Kesnand Road, A/P Wagholi, Tal- Haveli, Dist-Pune 412207, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.



Thereafter, an opportunity of hearing was granted to your college on **30.11.2022** to present the case through virtual mode.


